

How do I apply?

The first step in the application process is to come into the Centre and ask a Welcome Center associate for a membership application. You can also download one from the Centre's website at www.nracentre.com.

Once you have the application you will contact Darian Blattner at 243-0851 or via e-mail at dblattner@nracentre.com to schedule a 20 minute appointment with him to discuss your membership at the Centre.

For the appointment you will need to bring the following information with you:

- The completed membership application form
- Two forms of documentation to show your current income level
- A voided check, debit card, or credit card to set up your monthly bank draft for your membership

We will ask you to do two additional things before you membership will become active.

1. We will ask you to write a general thank you letter describing the benefits to you of a Centre membership. This would need to be turned in before your membership will be made active.
2. Be willing to volunteer at the Centre when an opportunity that fits your interests is available. We have many volunteer opportunities at the Centre including helping at Teen and Tween nights, family events, reading to children in Kids Kove, and help with mailings and other light administrative items.
