The Youth Character Initiative (YCI) is brought to our community through the generous support of the Otto Bremer Foundation. This two year initiative has been developed to provide kids in our community the opportunity to grow and gain leadership experiences through the Search Institute's 40 Developmental Asset approach.

This summer your child will spent time with kids their age learning about leadership and the 40 assets and putting those skills into action through community service projects, listening to guest speakers, taking field trips, and experiencing games and activities geared towards the goals of the YCI.

The grant received from the Otto Bremer Foundation allows us to offer this program at a greatly reduced rate. The cost per month is just \$15. This cost will include the field trips and daily snacks for the participants. Each participant will need to bring a sack lunch with drink to YCI each day. We offer wrap around care for those that need it for just \$15 additional per week.

Youth Character Initiative (YCI)

Youth Character Initiative (YCI) is a summer program for kids ages 10-15 (completed 5th grade through completion of 8th grade). The program is available through a generous grant from the Otto Bremer Foundation. The focus of YCI is to provide kids with a fun summer experience with the base of activities cemented by the 40 Developmental Assets. Each week YCI participants will learn with others their age how to work together, leadership skills, helping others through community centered projects, and having lots of fun at the Centre.

We offer flexible scheduling each week and participants need to attend at least 3 days per week to attend the weekly field trip. Your child will enjoy their day in age-appropriate groups and participate in activities geared towards their age group. Each week features a different theme as we explore nature, science, sports, technology, and more and how it relates to leadership and the 40 Developmental Assets. We will have weekly community service projects and six guest speakers throughout the summer. Each week includes swimming in the Centre pool and lots of outside fun. Your child will come home a little dirty and a lot tired after a day at YCI. Register for one month or the whole summer! Our program runs from June 7th through August 27th. There is a limit of 60 children to enroll in the program.

Fees: \$15 per participant per month or \$45 for the whole summer
You must make payment for the whole summer at time of registration (1, 2, or 3 months)

Program Hours: 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Additional Care is available from 6 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and again from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. for \$15 per week.

Your child would be entered into a group based on their age. The participants will determine the name of their group the first week of the summer.
